INTRODUCTION

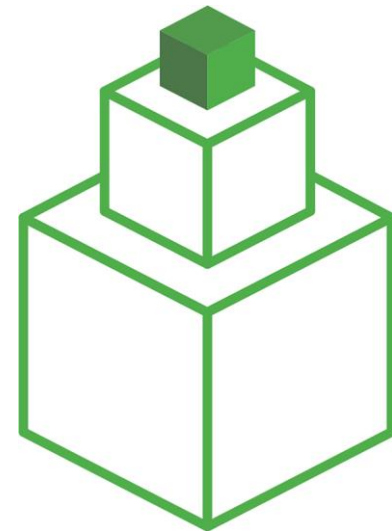
"LESS IS MORE"

The annual architectural competition MICRO ECO HOUSE 2021 supports the rule LESS IS MORE. This fundamental postulate is theoretically based on the idea of a minimalist house which represents a possible answer to this and the future generations about the existential and sustainable minimum needed for a living.

Participants in the MICRO ECO HOUSE 2021 competition should answer the task to design an object in which a young couple would hypothetically be housed. The only condition is that the useful floor area of the closed part of the space is not smaller than 7m^2 or exceeding 25m^2 . (Open spaces such as terraces, porches, roofs areas are not calculated in the squaring).

Apart from the fact that we expect creativity from the participants, they must also fulfill an additional condition, that they are not more than 30 years old, which applies to both graduated experts and students.



PRIZES / PROMOTION

Three winning works will be awarded in cash, and four special cash prizes will be awarded. Four student works will receive special award.

The total prize fund of € 3,000 is distributed as follows:

1 st PRIZE 1.500 €	2 nd PRIZE 700 €	3 rd PRIZE 400 €

<p>LOCATION</p> <p>There is no restriction as for the location of the object. It can be situated on a hypothetical location of any size, in the city or in the countryside, anywhere in the world.</p>	<p>FACILITY AREA</p> <p>The condition is that the total area of the building is not less than 7m² nor more than 25m² of indoor space. Open spaces such as porches, terraces, roof green areas and canopies are not calculated in the prescribed size span.</p>	<p>INFRASTRUCTURE</p> <p>Recommendations:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Propose a concept of a system for electricity generation. - Include a system for collecting and filtering atmospheric water - Develop a waste management strategy

CONTENT OF THE COMPETITION WORK AND SUBMISSION OF THE COMPETITION MATERIAL

All works should be appropriately graphically and textually presented, with freedom of authorial and creative approach in presentation.

- 1 Participants should present the complete paper in A2 format with a horizontal setting (not to exceed 5mb in size) with 3d views, bases, sections, diagrams, sketches and other presentation tools to explain their proposal.
- 2 In addition to the complete poster in A2 format given in Item 1, the competition work should include:
 - Spatial representations (renderings and perspectives) - two external and one internal in pdf format. The minimum size is 1,920x1,080 pixels
 - Basis of the building with marked furniture and equipment, A3 format, pdf in scale 1:50
 - Characteristic cross-sections in a scale of 1:50
 - Additional views as desired
 - Combine all attachments into one pdf file
 - Construction process shown in 3D, exploded axonometry, diagrams and schemes, A3 format, pdf
 - Textual description of the project up to 500 words, in Serbian, Croatian, Bosnian, Montenegrin or English.

In the subject of the e-mail, state: competition- (work code)

All graphic attachments and text descriptions in the upper right corner must have **a code - a seven-digit number**.

Participants determine the code themselves. In a separate pdf file bearing the name of the code, submit the participants data.

The official font of the tender documentation is ARIAL.

If the files are larger than 10MB, they should be sent by We-transfer.
